



## K-state Wesley Ministry Intern Covenant

Ministry Interns play a vital leadership role in the life of K-State Wesley. Ministry interns are asked to commit at least one academic year (August - May) of their lives to serving as part-time staff members of the K-State Wesley, United Methodist campus ministry. We believe that God clearly calls ministry leaders to high standards for life and leadership. Below are the requirements, expectations, and compensation for ministry interns:

### **Requirements for Ministry Interns:**

- A person of committed and contagious faith to God through Jesus Christ.
- For SOPHOMORES thru GRAD STUDENTS: Must have demonstrated leadership at the local church, district, or conference level of the United Methodist Church AND/OR have regularly participated in Wesley ministries for at least one semester.
- Must submit a letter of recommendation from a pastor, youth minister, or other ministry leader.

### **Expectations for Ministry Interns:**

- **Being a part-time staff member of K-State Wesley, 8 hours a week during academic year.**
- **Being a fully committed member of Wesley Leadership Team (see leadership covenant)**
- **Being the key ministry leader in one area of our campus ministry:**
  - Discipleship: overseeing small group ministry, equipping students to be small group leaders, one on one discipleship relationships with student leaders, small group leaders, and/or students and young adults in the larger Wesley community
  - Missions: overseeing and organizing mission trips and local service opportunities including our after-school ministry in Ogden, Spring Break Mission Trip, other mission trips, and other service projects. Recruiting student involvement in Wesley community and beyond the Wesley community for missions.
  - Outreach: reaching out to students and young adults at K-State and throughout the surrounding community. Participating in Activity Fairs, sidewalk chalking, information tables at the Union, etc. Contacting and follow-up with new students and potential students.
  - Worship: assisting campus minister in ordering the worship life of the Wesley community. Leading the Tuesday worship band, offering leadership to the Sunday emerging worship planning team. Recruiting and training students to be involved in worship leadership. Strong vocal and/or instrument skills are necessary.

### **Compensation for Ministry Interns:**

- \$1,000 scholarship each semester towards for housing within our residential community at K-State Wesley. Housing includes room, electricity, water, laundry, and Internet service (equivalent to 8 hours a week at \$8.33 per hour).
- Ministry Interns are permitted to have additional part-time employment as long as it does not interfere with their responsibilities as a ministry intern at K-State Wesley.

**I understand these requirements, expectations, and compensation of being a ministry interns with K-State Wesley, and I agree to be held accountable to these expectations for ministry interns.**
