



K-state Wesley "NEW STUDENT" Leadership Scholarship

Leadership development is a vital part of our campus ministry community at K-State Wesley. To help equip new students for future leadership at Wesley and in the United Methodist Church, we are offering two (2) new student leadership scholarships each year. New Student Leaders are asked to commit one academic year (August - May) of their lives to serving as part-time staff members of the K-State Wesley, United Methodist campus ministry. We believe that God clearly calls ministry leaders to high standards for life and leadership. Below are the requirements, expectations, and scholarships for new student leadership students.

Requirements for Freshman Leadership Scholarship:

- A person of committed and contagious faith to God through Jesus Christ.
- Must have demonstrated leadership at the local church, district, or conference level of the United Methodist Church. Open to freshmen, transfer students, or other new students.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from your pastor, youth minister, or conference ministry leader.



Expectations for Freshman Leaders:

- **Participating and assisting in FRESHLEY, our Wesley ministry to freshman and new students**
- **Being a fully committed member of the Wesley Leadership Team (see leadership covenant)**
- **Being a ministry assistant in one area of our campus ministry for 4 hours a week:**
 - Discipleship: assisting discipleship intern with small group ministry, helping to equip students to be small group leaders, one on one discipleship relationships with student leaders, small group leaders, and/or students and young adults in the larger Wesley community.
 - Missions: assisting in organizing mission trips and local service opportunities including our after-school ministry in Ogden, Spring Mission Trip, other mission trips, and other service projects. Recruiting student involvement in Wesley community and beyond the Wesley community for missions.
 - Outreach: reaching out to students and young adults at K-State and throughout the surrounding community. Participating in Activity Fairs, sidewalk chalking, information tables at the Union, etc. Contacting and helping to follow-up with new students and potential students.
 - Worship: assisting campus minister and worship intern/team in ordering the worship life of the Wesley community. Offering support to the Tuesday worship band, offering leadership to the Sunday worship planning team. Recruiting students to be involved in worship leadership. Strong vocal and/or instrument skills are not required, but could be helpful.

Scholarship for Freshman Leadership Students:

- \$500 scholarship each semester for housing within our residential community at K-State Wesley. Housing includes room, electricity, water, laundry, and Internet service (equivalent to 4 hours a week at \$8.33 per hour).
- New Student Leadership Students are permitted to have additional part-time employment as long as it does not interfere with their responsibilities as a new student leadership student at K-State Wesley.

I understand these requirements, expectations, and the scholarship for leadership students at K-State Wesley, and I agree to be held accountable to these expectations.
